

Mr. Soule had a 30+ year career with Battelle Memorial Institute (Columbus, Ohio) managing programs and assessing technologies associated with counterproliferation and national security-related industries, primarily in the CBRN arena. His last assignment with Battelle was as an expat on a Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA)-funded program in Tbilisi, Georgia, where he led collaborative team building, commercialization and sustainability, and training activities aimed at identifying international business and scientific collaborators for the Georgian bio-laboratory network.
